HOW TO MEASURE YOUR KITCHEN FOR CABINETS

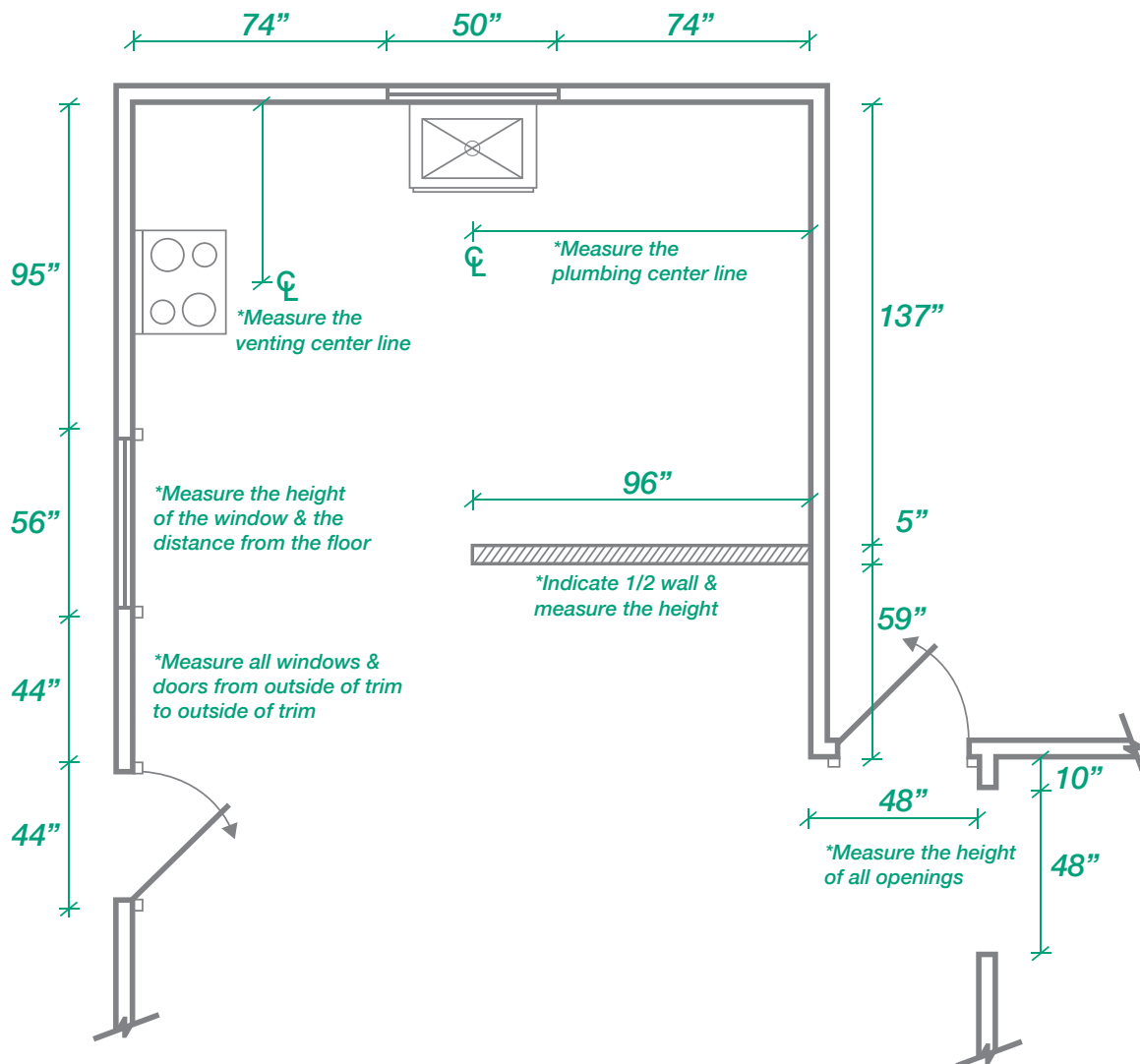
1. Draw out a rough sketch of your kitchen on a piece of paper.
2. Transfer the rough sketch from paper to the grid paper.
3. Make sure to mark all of your measurements only in inches, e.g. 8' 10" should be written as 106".
4. Measure all of the window and door openings from the farthest part of the trim edge to the other farthest end of the trim edge.
5. Be sure to include an indication as to the direction the door swings as well.

MEASURING YOUR KITCHEN

1. Pick one corner of the room to start in, and measure the full length of that wall.
2. Continue to do this for the other walls of the kitchen until you have the whole room measured in inches.
3. Be sure that you are measuring from the outside of the trim edges to the far walls, as this extra bit can make a big difference in the long run.
4. Double check your work to ensure that all of your smaller measurements add up to the overall wall measurements

MEASURING FIXTURES & UTILITIES

1. Measure all of the objects in the room that affix to the wall such as windows, doors, electrical outlets, ventilation duct work, AC vents, etc.
